

The City of Dollard-des-Ormeaux receives a major grant for the development of a strategy leading to the implementation of new green infrastructure

Dollard-des-Ormeaux, August 26, 2025 — The City of Dollard-des-Ormeaux is pleased to announce that it has received a grant of **\$975,794** from the Government of Québec under the **Oasis program**, stemming from the **2030 Plan for a Green Economy**, to support the planning of climate change adaptation projects. This funding will launch the first phase of its **Blue-Green Strategy**, focused on the development of sustainable green infrastructure.

Thanks to this financial support, the City will undertake a rigorous planning process to identify the most effective sustainable solutions to **address urgent environmental challenges such as heat islands and extreme rainfall events**.

“This is a structuring project that will have tangible benefits on the quality of life of our residents, today and in the years to come. We want to build a city that is more resilient, greener, and better adapted to climate realities,” emphasized Mayor Alex Bottausci.

Already recognized for its abundance of green spaces and human-scale neighbourhoods, Dollard-des-Ormeaux seeks to strengthen this vocation by integrating innovative developments such as targeted plantings, permeable surfaces, stormwater retention areas, and other measures that will be defined as part of the planning process.

This unifying project is led by the team at the Urban Planning and Engineering Department, which the City thanks for its dedication and rigour in carrying out this structuring initiative for the future of our community.

The Blue-Green Strategy is part of a vision of a city looking to the future. A greener future begins here, in Dollard-des-Ormeaux.
